## Dance Expectations

Date: October 15, 2011  
Time: 8:00-11:00 p.m.  
Location: Harper Creek High School

1. **Students may be checked** for illegal, unauthorized or controlled substances prior to entry to the dance area. Administration and/or police liaison officer may conduct "pat downs" and purse searches. Any student who refuses to comply with searching will be denied entry.
2. **Any vehicle in the parking and attendee drop-off area can be searched** at any time. DANCE ATTENDEES WILL BE HELD RESPONSIBLE AND GIVEN CONSEQUENCES FOR ANY UNAUTHORIZED OBJECT OR FOR ANY ILLEGAL SUBSTANCE IN THE VEHICLE.
3. **Students will not be permitted to enter before the designated start time** of the dance.
4. **If a student is not picked up within 30 minutes of the end of the dance**, he or she will not be allowed to attend the next dance.
5. **Once a student has entered the dance** they are not permitted to leave the premises. If a student does leave the premises they will not be allowed to re-enter.

**Dancing Guidelines** (applies on and off the dance floor): Lewd and lascivious dancing such as "Freaking" will result in a student being warned and repeat offenses will result in being asked to leave the event. It will also make him or her ineligible to attend all future dances for the remainder of the school year. Parents will be notified. Dancing guidelines include, but are not limited to:

- **No groping (No touching of breasts, buttocks, or genitals)**
- **No thrusting**
- **No bending over**
- **Minimal body to body contact (At the discretion of the Chaperones)**
- **No "making out" (no overt and/or prolonged public displays of affection.)**

-Respect will be demonstrated towards the chaperones at all times.

### **Dress Code**

#### **Formal Dance Attire & Requirements (Students will be sent home for inappropriate dress.)**

During special dances such as Homecoming, Winter Carnival, and Prom, the student dress code is modified in the following manners:

1. Formal dresses or gowns may be strapless or may feature spaghetti straps. These garments must cover the bust area. Gowns and dresses with slits that are above the mid-thigh area are not permitted. The length of the dress must also fall below the mid-thigh area.
  2. Girls' upper back may be open but only down to their bra-line or mid-back.
  3. Bare stomachs or midriffs are not permitted
  4. All males must wear shirts, with sleeves, that must be worn at all times.
- Dresses need to be mid thigh length or longer and chaperones will monitor to make sure they do not ride up while the students are dancing.
5. Harper Creek students planning on bringing guests must receive permission from administration prior to the dance.
  6. All other general appearance rules apply.
  7. Normal Harper Creek Dress Code will be enforced for all other non-formal attire.

\*\*\*Once students are admitted into the dance, **if they alter their attire** in such a way as to make it violate the specified dress code standards, they will be removed from dance, parents will be notified to pick up their child, and **they will not be permitted to attend all remaining dances for the school year.**
